



Start by Looking Back

With bidding starting at £70,000 a life-size bronze statue of **Her Late Majesty Queen Elizabeth II** riding **Burmese** is to be auctioned. Who knows what the hammer price will be?

The bronze, by renowned equine artist **Caroline Wallace** is of Her Majesty at the **Trooping of the Colour** parade in 1984. Offered for sale is the second casting of only two, the mould having been destroyed, the first being commissioned by the **Royal Military Academy, Sandhurst**.

Burmese was given to Her Majesty by the **Royal Canadian Mounted Police** in 1969 and carried her on 18 consecutive Trooping of the Colour parades. The partnership became a defining symbol of grace, loyalty, and trust. Wallace captures that relationship with extraordinary anatomical precision and emotional clarity.

This work represents a unique convergence of royal history, artistic mastery, and British heritage. We look forward to discovering its new home in 2026.
